How TSheets can help

How are you currently calculating hours for payroll?

Paper time cards, Excel spreadsheets, punch-style clocks, honor system, text messages

All these can reveal underlying inefficiencies and time-consuming practices with inaccurate data

- Automated time tracking from multiple devices that sync in real time
- Employees can track their time via a mobile app, kiosk or desktop
- Administrators and managers can easily see who's working when and where, in real time
- Time is recorded with to-the-second accuracy
- No more manual data entry

What are you doing to ensure your employees are not adding additional time?

Employees may be rounding up their hours or buddy punching

Time theft leads to millions of dollars paid out for work that didn't happen

GPS tracking:

TSheets' mobile apps for iPhone and Android automatically attach GPS location points to employee timesheets when they clock in and out and change job codes each day. GPS tracking allows employers to see where employees are working when they're on the clock, allowing employers to better manage their teams and allocate resources

Time Clock Kiosk:

Enable photo capture and facial recognition, and you'll get an instant alert if an employee isn't who they say they are. Confirm employees are who they say they are and deter buddy punching from happening in the first place

How have you built out a schedule?

Time-consuming manual calendars and paper schedules take a lot of admin time to manage

They often aren't flexible enough to cope with changing circumstances:

- Time-consuming
- Missed shifts
- Not knowing who is going to turn up for what job

TSheets scheduling:

- Fast and easy to build and share schedules with employees
- Send employees push notifications to remind them where they need to be or if there is a change of plan
- Attach addresses for jobs and locations
- Sync with other calendar apps
- Create templates or create draft schedules before you publish

Do you have a remote service staff?

- Not knowing where employees are
- Wasting time as employees need to go to the office to clock in before hitting the job
- Not knowing how much was travel time versus time on the job
- Having to drive from site to site to check that employees are where they are supposed to be

Who's working window

Know exactly who's working and where at any point of the day. See a list of who's clocked in and how long they've been working, along with everyone's location pinned to a single map

Mobile app

Employees can clock in and out at the touch of a button, as well as see exactly where they need to be for each job. GPS tracking makes it easy to see how much time was spent traveling versus on the job

Clock in your crew

As an alternative to individuals clocking in, managers can use the crew function in their TSheets app to start and stop the clock for an entire group of employees in one action

Do you have issues with overtime?

- Unplanned overtime
- Retroactively paying out overtime after calculating worked hours
- FLSA concerns

Overtime alerts

Proactive: Time turns red when an employee hits overtime, and overtime alerts sent to manager before overtime happens

How do you determine job costing or how profitable a job was?

- Not knowing how many hours were spent on a job
- Difficulties knowing how profitable a job was because employees' hours aren't tracked to a job

It's simple to track time against customers, jobs, service items, and whether a job is billable. The data all flows back into QuickBooks Online for improved accuracy in invoicing and job costing
