Mail your payment with the form NC-5P.

1. Review the account information on the displayed form. To edit, go to your account settings.
2. Print your form.
3. Write a check for the total amount due, payable to: NCDOR.
4. Mail the NC-5P and check to the agency using the address on the form. Or go to the agency website and follow their instructions.

You can view your submitted form in your **Archived forms**.

You can view a record of this payment in your **Tax payment history report**.

**Your payment is due: 04/05/2023**

**Important:** If you are paying after the due date, you may owe penalties and interest. Send in the payment for the tax you owe, and contact the Department of Revenue for assistance in calculating any late charges.
